Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Questionnaire

For physician attendees whose certification is through the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM), Maintenance of Certification (MOC) points are available for symposium attendance and engagement. Successful completion of this continuing medical education (CME) activity, which includes participation in the evaluation component, enables the participant to earn up to 77.25 MOC points in the ABIM's MOC program. Participants will earn MOC points equivalent to the amount of CME credits claimed for the activity. It is the CME activity provider's responsibility to submit participant completion information to **Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education** (ACCME) for the purpose of granting ABIM MOC credit.

To receive ABIM MOC, participants must complete and submit their SABCS Evaluation and Post Survey and claim their CME credits for the meeting. Once these steps are completed, UT Health San Antonio Continuing Medical Education office will transmit all information to ACCME on the participant's behalf.

ABIM MOC points will only be awarded if the attendee has completed their SABCS Evaluation, Post Survey, claimed CME credits and completed the MOC questionnaire with detailed responses that demonstrate specific knowledge gained at the Symposium and how that knowledge may apply to practice.
